Big Bus Tours

The open-top double-decker buses stop at many key locations around the city, so you can easily hop off and explore, then hop back on to continue your journey. Along the way, enjoy the insightful recorded commentary (available in 10 languages) to get a deeper understanding of the history and culture of this incredible city.

The tours include two Hop-on Hop-off daytime routes and a Panoramic Night Tour:

- The **Hong Kong Island Tour (Red Route)** takes you to Hong Kong's iconic attractions, from gleaming skyscrapers to traditional temples. Shop in Causeway Bay, admire the skyline in Central and experience Hong Kong's bustling nightlife. Don't miss the famous Man Mo Temple!
- Escape the hustle and bustle on the **Stanley Tour (Green Route)**, winding south to beaches, markets and nature. Enjoy scenic views of Hong Kong's countryside, coastline and harbours. Relax at the picturesque Repulse Bay with luxury beachfront dining against the mountainous backdrop; then shop for bargains at the famous Stanley Market.
- The **Night Tour in Kowloon** travels through the centre of Kowloon, covering Yau Ma Tei, Mongkok and Tsim Sha Tsui.

The estimated duration may vary depending on your interests and the amount of time you spend at each stop. Each route typically takes about 1.5 to 2.5 hours.

The Peak Experience



The highest point on Hong Kong Island, this has been the city's most exclusive neighbourhood since pre-handover times — back then it was the cooler air that attracted the rich and famous; in the post air-conditioning era, the views of one of the world's most spectacular cityscapes keep them coming. By day your eyes stretch across sparkling skyscrapers and Victoria Harbour all the way to the green hills of the New Territories. In early evening this panorama melts into pink and orange before reincarnating as a dazzling galaxy of light, shimmering beneath you. And if you listen carefully enough, you can hear the city humming below.

You can spend as much time as you like at The Peak, depending on your personal interests. We recommend at least 1 hour for viewing the night scenery.
